Where and when did the road start?

Tunis November 2005:

“convene a multi-stakeholder dialogue”

- Discuss public policy issues related to key elements of Internet governance in order to foster the sustainability, robustness, security, stability and development of the Internet
- Discuss issues that do not fall within the scope of any existing body
- Facilitate the exchange of information and best practices
- Propose ways and means to accelerate the availability and affordability of the Internet in the developing world
- Help to find solutions to the issues arising from the use and misuse of the Internet, of particular concern to everyday users

Where and when did the road start?

The Internet Governance Forum would have no oversight function and would not replace existing:

- arrangements
- mechanisms
- institutions or
- organisations

but would involve them and take advantage of their expertise.

It would be constituted as a neutral, non-duplicative and non-binding process.

It would have no involvement in day-to-day or technical operations of the Internet.

Two consultative meetings in Geneva (in February and May)

Creation of Secretariat (March)

Establishment of the Advisory Group (May)

- 5 special advisors

Sharing of Best Practice

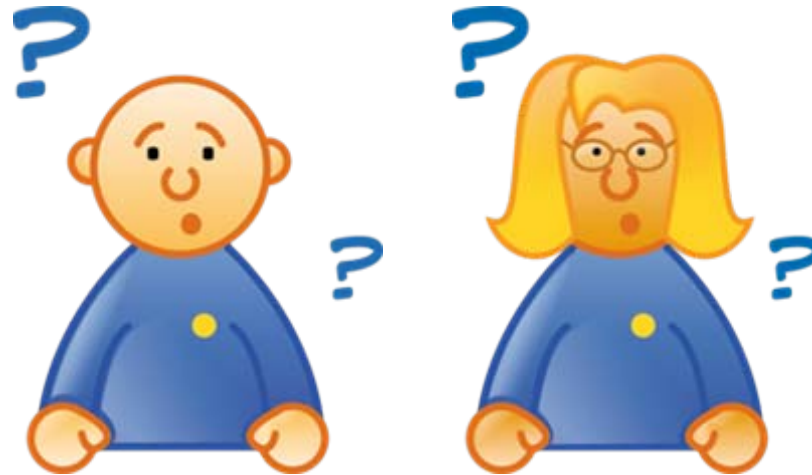
On the road
